Tort "Reform" A license to kill, maim and steal.

In a perfect world, hospitals wouldn't kill 100,000 patients a year, corporations wouldn't swindle the public out of billions of dollars, manufacturers wouldn't kill thousands of customers just to make more money, doctors wouldn't ever destroy a patient's life because they're incompetent, careless, or on drugs, and there wouldn't be a need for any trial lawyers.

We don't think that's the right approach. We'd rather *limit the number of people they kill, maim, and swindle every year* than limit the amount they have to pay for doing it.

Tort "reform" It's all about money.

The doctors, insurance companies, corporations, and our legislators are out to get the "greedy" trial lawyers, because "the trial lawyers don't care about anything but money." So how are they going to get rid of us? By reducing the amount of money the doctors, insurance companies, and corporations have to pay when they when they kill, maim, or swindle someone. So who are the "greedy" ones?

If they're so desperate to make more money, why don't they just stop killing, maiming, and swindling people? That way they could get rid of the trial lawyers, too. But until they do, people like you, and your children, and the little old lady who lives next door need someone to see that your rights are upheld. Someone who will fight toe-to-toe with the highly paid corporate attorneys. To make them pay, and pay until it hurts, not just

because you deserve it, but also in the hope that the fear of similar payouts in the future will make them stop and think before they kill, maim, or swindle someone else.
